



2024 Scholarship Application

1. The scholarship shall be known as the Cambria-Friesland Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship.
2. Cambria-Friesland Area Chamber will announce whether the scholarship shall be available for the current year. This announcement shall be no later than February 28.
3. Application for this scholarship should be neatly filled out with the essay typed. It should be mailed or emailed no later than **April 30, 2024.**

4. **Amount:** The amount of this scholarship shall be \$500 awarded up to six individuals, paid upon the successful completion of the program/semester. (C average or better for college/technical school)
5. **Eligibility:** Anyone seeking a certificate (for example: CDL), vocational or college that is an immediate family member (self, spouse, grandchild or child) or employee or employee's child of a CFA Chamber Member may apply. Only one application may be submitted per Chamber Member. Businesses that are Chamber members are encouraged to pass along this benefit to their employees and employee's children. Note: if more than 1 person from a CFACC business, it is the responsibility of the business, not the Chamber to determine which applicant will move forward to be considered for the scholarship.
6. **Payment: Students will submit transcripts to the address above and the Treasurer will write a check to the student. Should the recipient of the scholarship choose not to enroll for the first semester of the academic year immediately following, the scholarship will be forfeited.**

Eligibility

- Chamber members
- Those that work for a Chamber member company
- Children/grandchildren of those that work for a Chamber member company
- High school and college students
- Non-traditional students looking for a second career
- One application per student per school calendar year. (Note: a new application must be completed and submitted each time. Failure to submit a current application and original essay will result in the application being disqualified. Individuals may receive up to 1 scholarship per school calendar year.
- One applicant per Chamber member per school calendar year (Note: if more than one person from a CFACC business applies, it is the responsibility of the business (not the Chamber) to determine which applicant will move forward to be considered for the scholarship.)
